About the Founder of BTP: Originally from Chicago, Siobhan is the Founder of BlueRose Theatre Project, a new youth theater company based in Escondido. She has 20 years experience working as a professional actor, director and choreographer. While in Chicago she served as Director of Drama for Cantilever Network, Artistic Associate for Porchlight Music Theatre, and mentor for the acclaimed Steppenwolf Theatre's Crosstown Exchange. She is a former casting associate for O'Brien/Louer Casting where she worked on projects for NBC, Disney, Miramax, and Broadway. Since moving to San Diego Siobhan has directed for Arts Off Broadway, BTAA and ACT among others. In conjunction with Mo'olelo Performing Arts Company, the International Rescue Committee and the San Diego Public Library Siobhan developed the *My Home* project in which she worked with a group of High School refugee students from around the world helping them create a theatre piece telling their personal stories. Siobhan served as Artistic Director of Broadway Theatre Arts Academy and Performing Arts Manager/Artistic Director for the Joan B. Kroc School of the Arts, Kroc Kids and Verge Theatre Company. Siobhan is a private acting and vocal coach whose background is in Expressive Arts Therapy and her emphasis is on developing programs for youth to encourage their sense of self and give them the tools they need to communicate effectively throughout their lives.
